RE: COVID-19 Update: Testing

Citrus College community,

Thank you for your continued cooperation and support of the college's weekly COVID-19 testing requirement.

Last week, in an effort to make sure all students completed a COVID-19 test upon return from spring break, the daily symptom check passes were set to red on the campus mobile app. We apologize for any confusion this may have caused any of our students, faculty and staff.

As students completed their COVID-19 test at the on-campus testing site this week, their red passes should have been cleared; however, it appears that some students have continued to experience a red pass. This should not be the case once the student completes the questionnaire and all of the required steps.

If you have an erroneous red pass, the most efficient way to have your pass reset to green is to visit the testing site located in the lobby of the Haugh Performing Arts Center.
