This past Saturday, at a time when many family members and friends were celebrating the Lunar New Year, a mass shooting in Monterey Park tragically took the lives of 10 people and injured 10 more from our nearby communities. Our Citrus College family includes many students, faculty and staff from Monterey Park and cities throughout the San Gabriel Valley. Our hearts are with the victims, their families and all those affected by this senseless act of violence.

At Citrus College, we are committed to creating and sustaining a community that is safe and free of hate and violence. We recognize that many in our Asian American and Pacific Islander communities are experiencing sadness and suffering, and we stand with you.

The Langley Senior Center in Monterey Park is offering counseling, support and reunification for the community. In addition, Citrus College has resources in place to support our students, faculty and staff.
