Dear Citrus College Family,

As mentioned at Tuesday's Board meeting, it is with great sadness that I write to inform you that former trustee Michael J. Bevilacqua passed away on March 26, 2023, at the age of 90.

Mr. Bevilacqua was elected to the Citrus Community College District Board of Trustees in 1987. He represented the Glendora area (Trustee Area 4) and served in all officer roles during his tenure, before retiring in 2007. During his time at Citrus College, Mr. Bevilacqua served alongside three superintendent/presidents: Dr. Dan Angel, Dr. Louis E. Zellers and Dr. Michael J. Viera.

A Glendora resident, Mr. Bevilacqua served as director of physical therapy at Foothill Presbyterian Hospital and operated a private practice in Glendora until his retirement. He was a member of several professional and civic organizations and served as president of the University of Southern California Physical Therapy School Alumni Association, the Glendora Rotary Club and Foothill Presbyterian Hospital Men's Club.

"Mike Bevilacqua was a strong supporter of education in the Glendora community and was a dedicated board member for Citrus College for 20 years," said Board Clerk/Secretary Dr. Patricia A. Rasmussen. "He cared about students, staff and the campus in general, and was proud to be a member of the Board of Trustees. I know as a businessman, he touched the lives of many and he will be missed terribly by those who knew him."
