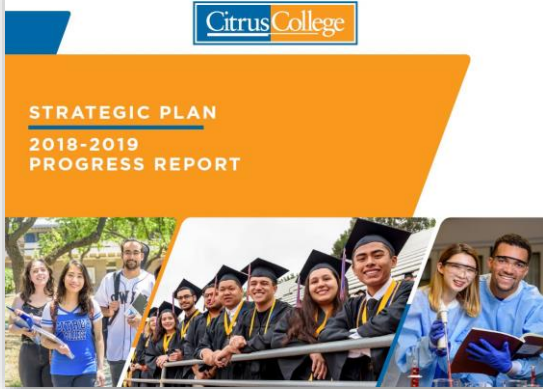

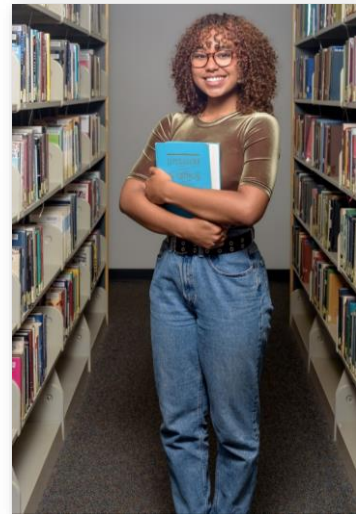

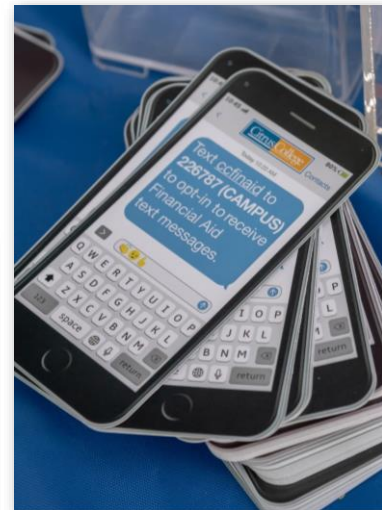

- New student orientation platform helps students streamline their academic path



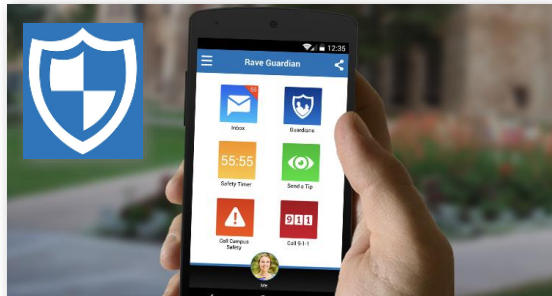
## Citrus College Focus Area 5: Student Support (cont.)
