

Tracking Students in Basic Skills English

The data presented here was originally produced for Citrus College's revised Student Equity Plan (SEP) in Fall 2016. In year two of funding, the internal evaluation committee agreed upon using the academic year of 2012-2013 to establish cohorts. This allowed for a three year time period (academic years: 2012-13, 2013-14, and 2014-15) to track completion without "spilling" into the year in which SEP funds began to be dispersed (2015-2016).

Information in this Document

This document contains flow charts which illustrate the progression of students **who started at ENGL098**, and follows them through the English course sequence. These flow charts are labeled as follows:

- Exhibit A – 3 year progression (12-13 Cohort)
- Exhibit B – 3 year progression (13-14 Cohort)
- Exhibit C – 2 year progression (14-15 Cohort)
- Exhibit D – 1 year progression (15-16 Cohort)

After each Exhibit you will also find data answering the following questions.

- What percentage of students successfully completed ENGL099?
- What percentage of students who complete 099 then go on to ENGL101?
- Of those who continued to ENGL101, what percentage succeed?

Definitions

Enrollment count is the number of students who earned a grade of A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, FW, or W

Success count is the number of students who earned a grade of A, B, C, or P

Unsuccessful count is the number of students who earned a grade of D, F, NP, FW, or W

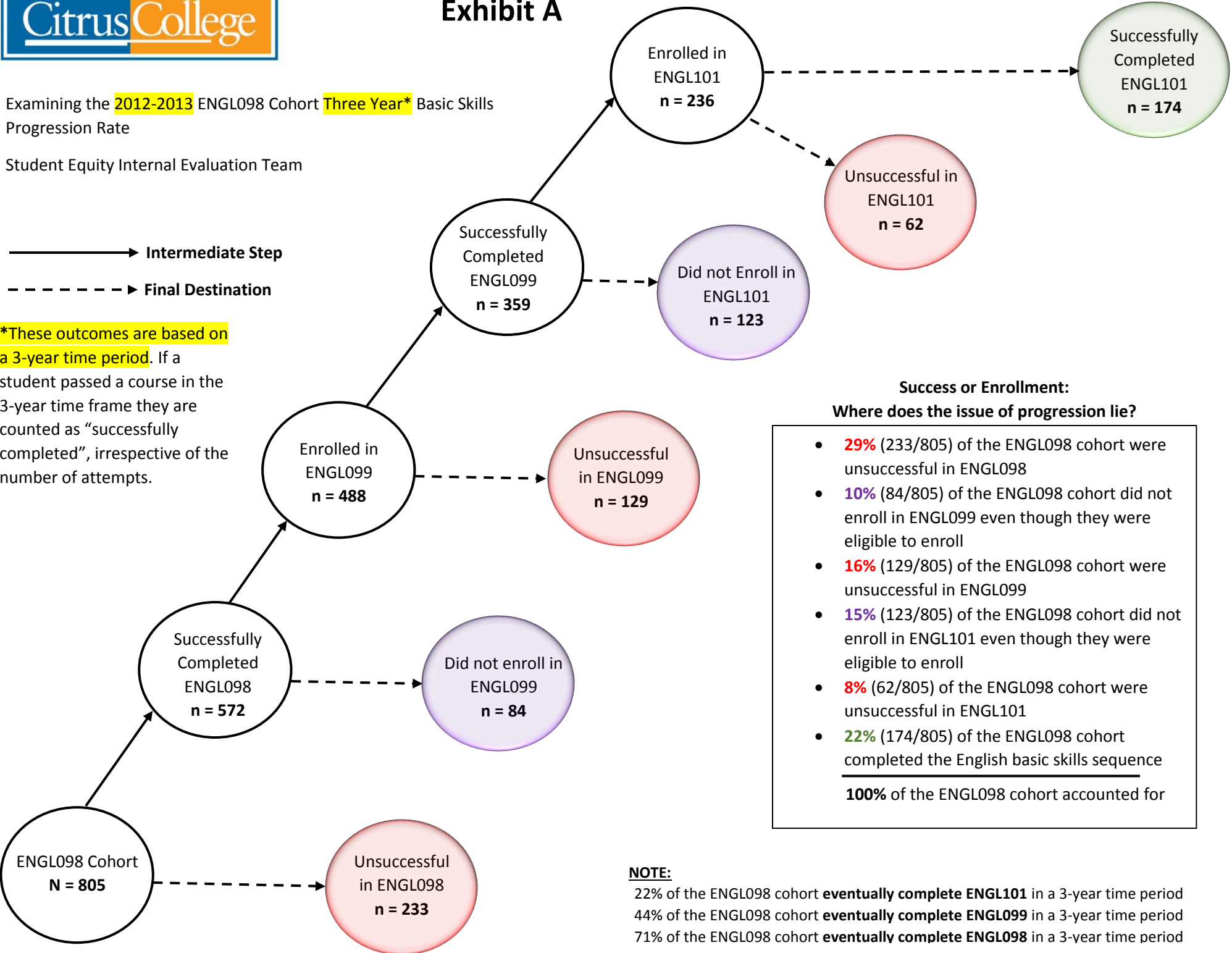

**Success or Enrollment:
Where does the issue of progression lie?**

- **29%** (233/805) of the ENGL098 cohort were unsuccessful in ENGL098
- **10%** (84/805) of the ENGL098 cohort did not enroll in ENGL099 even though they were eligible to enroll
- **16%** (129/805) of the ENGL098 cohort were unsuccessful in ENGL099
- **15%** (123/805) of the ENGL098 cohort did not enroll in ENGL101 even though they were eligible to enroll
- **8%** (62/805) of the ENGL098 cohort were unsuccessful in ENGL101
- **22%** (174/805) of the ENGL098 cohort completed the English basic skills sequence

100% of the ENGL098 cohort accounted for

NOTE:
 22% of the ENGL098 cohort **eventually complete ENGL101** in a 3-year time period
 44% of the ENGL098 cohort **eventually complete ENGL099** in a 3-year time period
 71% of the ENGL098 cohort **eventually complete ENGL098** in a 3-year time period

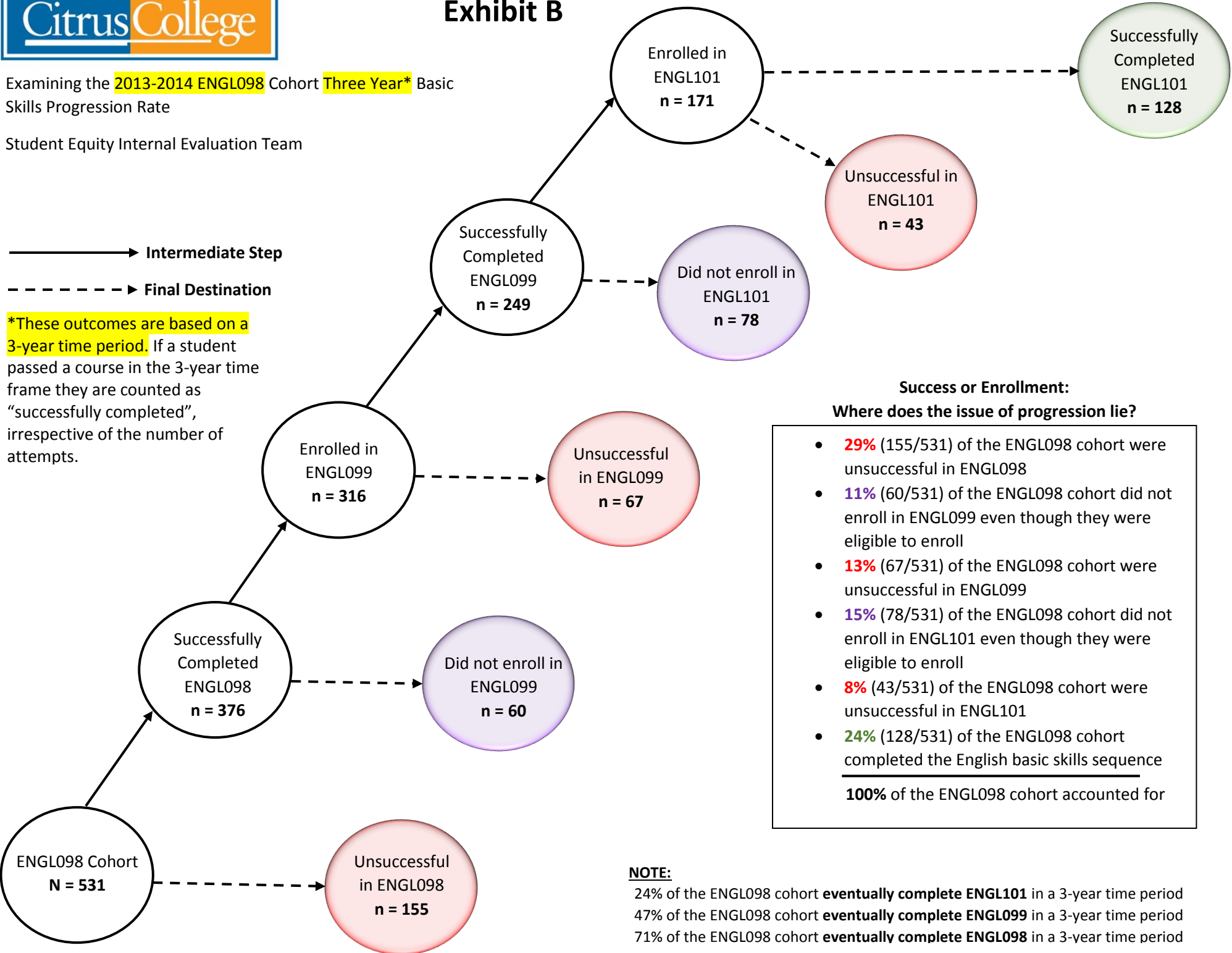

**Success or Enrollment:
Where does the issue of progression lie?**

- **29%** (155/531) of the ENGL098 cohort were unsuccessful in ENGL098
- **11%** (60/531) of the ENGL098 cohort did not enroll in ENGL099 even though they were eligible to enroll
- **13%** (67/531) of the ENGL098 cohort were unsuccessful in ENGL099
- **15%** (78/531) of the ENGL098 cohort did not enroll in ENGL101 even though they were eligible to enroll
- **8%** (43/531) of the ENGL098 cohort were unsuccessful in ENGL101
- **24%** (128/531) of the ENGL098 cohort completed the English basic skills sequence

100% of the ENGL098 cohort accounted for

 24% of the ENGL098 cohort **eventually complete ENGL101** in a 3-year time period
 47% of the ENGL098 cohort **eventually complete ENGL099** in a 3-year time period
 71% of the ENGL098 cohort **eventually complete ENGL098** in a 3-year time period

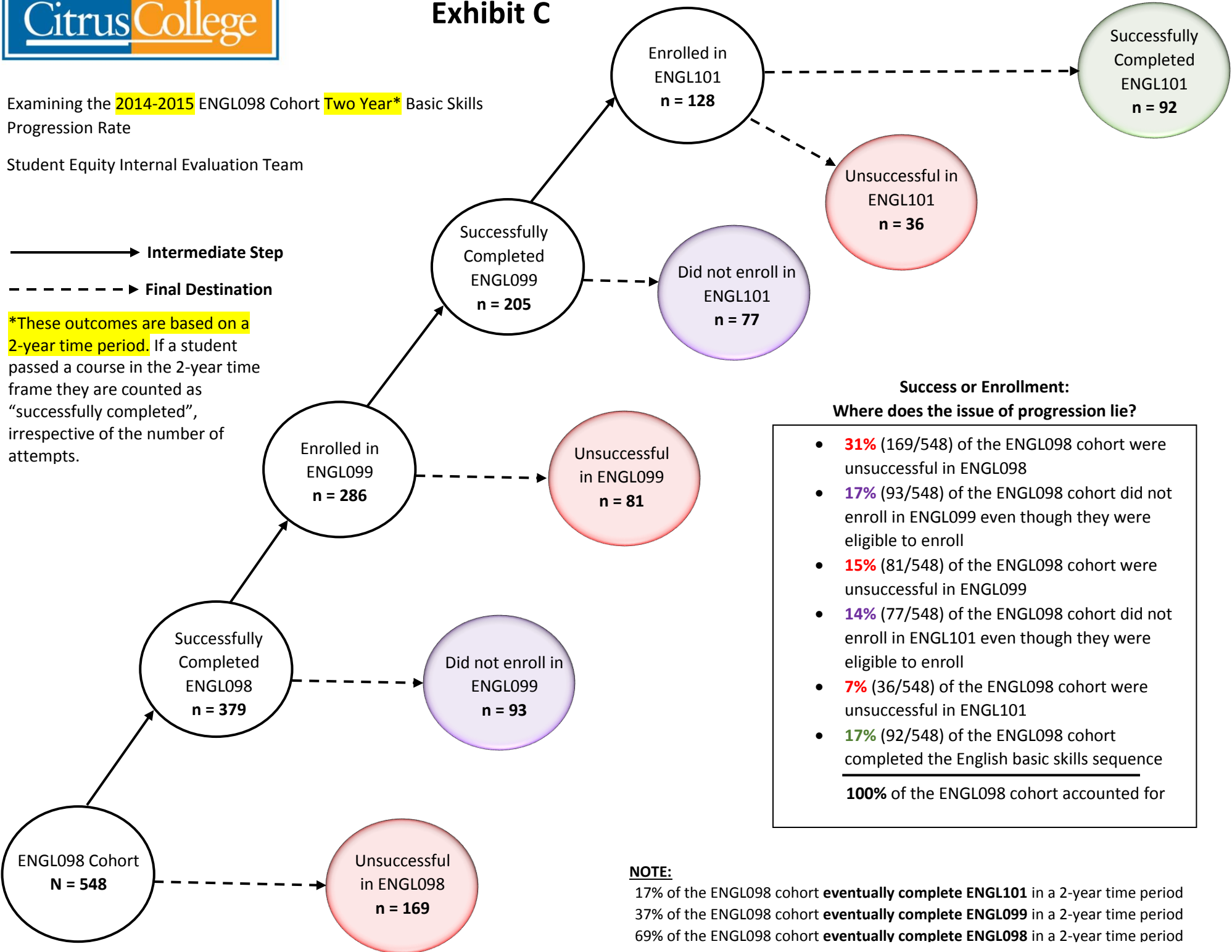

Success or Enrollment: Where does the issue of progression lie?

- **31%** (169/548) of the ENGL098 cohort were unsuccessful in ENGL098
 - **17%** (93/548) of the ENGL098 cohort did not enroll in ENGL099 even though they were eligible to enroll
 - **15%** (81/548) of the ENGL098 cohort were unsuccessful in ENGL099
 - **14%** (77/548) of the ENGL098 cohort did not enroll in ENGL101 even though they were eligible to enroll
 - **7%** (36/548) of the ENGL098 cohort were unsuccessful in ENGL101
 - **17%** (92/548) of the ENGL098 cohort completed the English basic skills sequence
- 100%** of the ENGL098 cohort accounted for

NOTE:

17% of the ENGL098 cohort **eventually complete ENGL101** in a 2-year time period
 37% of the ENGL098 cohort **eventually complete ENGL099** in a 2-year time period
 69% of the ENGL098 cohort **eventually complete ENGL098** in a 2-year time period

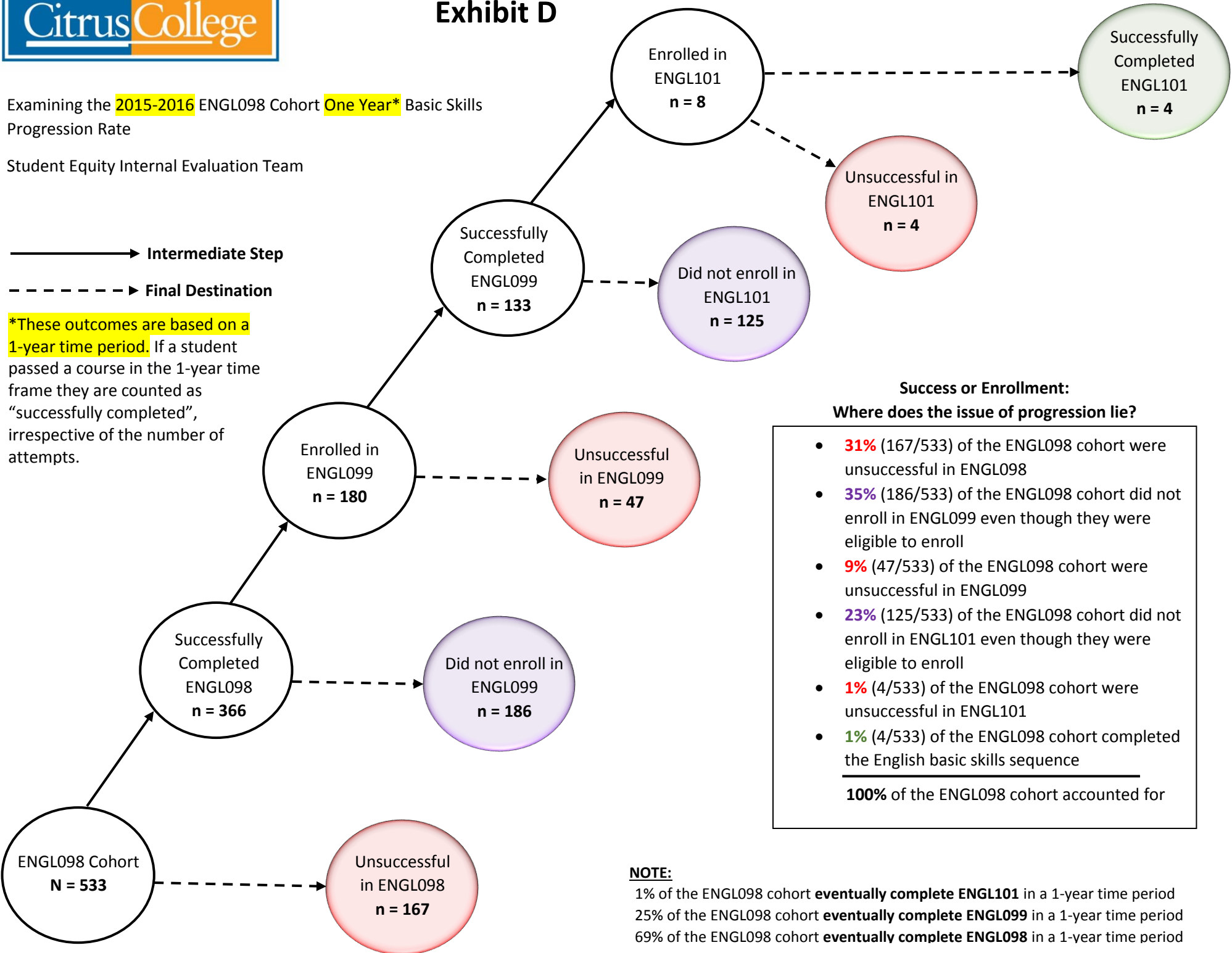

*These outcomes are based on a 1-year time period. If a student passed a course in the 1-year time frame they are counted as “successfully completed”, irrespective of the number of attempts.



**Success or Enrollment:
Where does the issue of progression lie?**

- **31%** (167/533) of the ENGL098 cohort were unsuccessful in ENGL098
- **35%** (186/533) of the ENGL098 cohort did not enroll in ENGL099 even though they were eligible to enroll
- **9%** (47/533) of the ENGL098 cohort were unsuccessful in ENGL099
- **23%** (125/533) of the ENGL098 cohort did not enroll in ENGL101 even though they were eligible to enroll
- **1%** (4/533) of the ENGL098 cohort were unsuccessful in ENGL101
- **1%** (4/533) of the ENGL098 cohort completed the English basic skills sequence

NOTE:
 1% of the ENGL098 cohort **eventually complete ENGL101** in a 1-year time period
 25% of the ENGL098 cohort **eventually complete ENGL099** in a 1-year time period
 69% of the ENGL098 cohort **eventually complete ENGL098** in a 1-year time period

Exhibit A

- What percentage of students complete 99?
 - **74%** (359/488) successfully complete ENGL099
- What percentage of students who complete 99 then go on to 101?
 - **66%** (236/359) successfully completed ENGL099 and enrolled in ENGL101
- Of those who continued to ENGL101, what percentage succeed?
 - Of the 236 students that enrolled in ENGL101 (after successfully completing ENGL099), **74%** (174/236) successfully completed ENGL101

Exhibit B

- What percentage of students complete 99?
 - **79%** (249/316) successfully complete ENGL099
- What percentage of students who complete 99 then go on to 101?
 - **69%** (171/249) successfully completed ENGL099 and enrolled in ENGL101
- Of those who continued to ENGL101, what percentage succeed?
 - Of the 171 students that enrolled in ENGL101 (after successfully completing ENGL099), **75%** (128/171) successfully completed ENGL101

Exhibit C

- What percentage of students complete 99?
 - **72%** (205/286) successfully complete ENGL099
- What percentage of students who complete 99 then go on to 101?
 - **62%** (128/205) successfully completed ENGL099 and enrolled in ENGL101
- Of those who continued to ENGL101, what percentage succeed?
 - Of the 128 students that enrolled in ENGL101 (after successfully completing ENGL099), **72%** (92/128) successfully completed ENGL101

Exhibit D

- What percentage of students complete 99?
 - **74%** (133/180) successfully complete ENGL099
- What percentage of students who complete 99 then go on to 101?
 - **6%** (8/133) successfully completed ENGL099 and enrolled in ENGL101
- Of those who continued to ENGL101, what percentage succeed?
 - Of the 8 students that enrolled in ENGL101 (after successfully completing ENGL099), **50%** (4/8) successfully completed ENGL101
