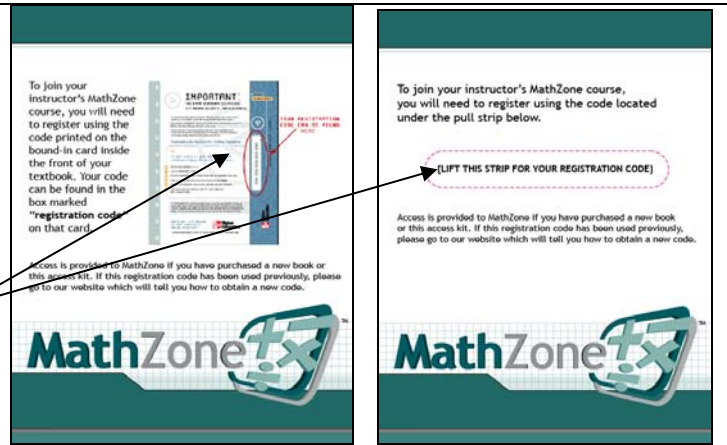


Student QuickStart Guide - MathZone

First Time Registration

1. Go to www.mathzone.com and from the drop-down menu, choose the book you are using in your course.
2. Click on the link "First time user? Register now by following this link."
3. Click on the link "I am a Student."
4. Click on the link "I have a registration code that came with my book."
5. Enter the alpha-numeric code packaged with the text or included in your MathZone student kit.
6. Click the **Continue** button.



Your Account Information

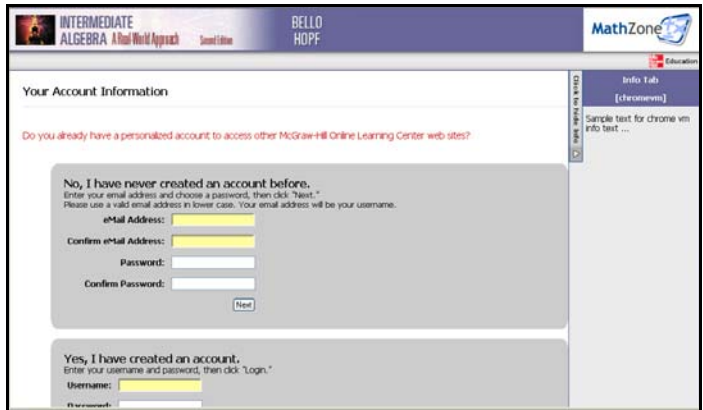

Then click the **Create Account** button.



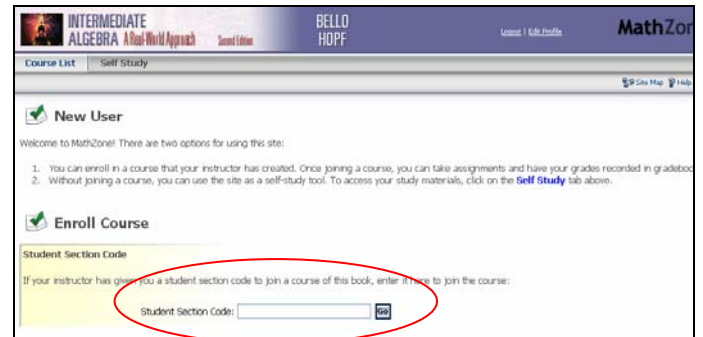
New User / Enroll in Course

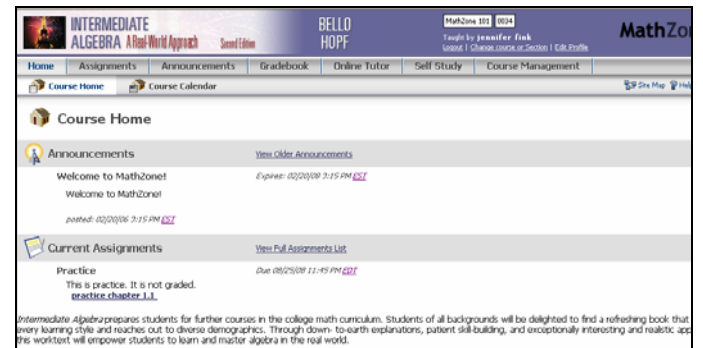
Then click the **Go** button.
