- Eligibility to Apply:**
- 1) An overall GPA of 2.5 or above for the core sciences: Anatomy, Physiology and Microbiology with a minimum of “C” or better.
 - 2) Completion of English 101 with a “C” or better.
 - 3) Cumulative GPA of 2.5 for *ALL* college course work taken.
 - 4) Core sciences must have been completed within the last five (5) years.

• Need to work - student worked at least part-time while completing RN prerequisite courses(s) within the last 5 years.			Letter from employer, on organization letterhead, verifying employment while completing courses.
• Refugee status			Documentation or letter from USCIS.

NOTE:

- **Course work from ALL colleges/universities must be submitted two weeks prior to the application. Any applicant who does not submit all coursework at the time of application shall be disqualified from consideration; or dismissed from the program.**
- Each letter/document may be used as verification for only ONE criterion. Separate documents must be submitted to receive points for each criterion: health experience, life experience and proficiency in another language. All letters must be on letterhead and must include a signature and contact information.
- All applicants are required to take the ATI TEAS®. TEAS score reports from other schools will be accepted. Students must meet or exceed the adjusted individual total cut score of 62% in order to be enrolled in the subsequent fall semester.
