MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
CITRUS COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT

August 18, 2009

The Board of Trustees of the Citrus Community College District met for the Regular Meeting on Tuesday, August 18, 2009, in the Administration Building Board Room.

Board President Keith called the meeting to order at 4:15 p.m. Board President Keith led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

COMMENTS FROM THE AUDIENCE

Judith L. Walker from Upland, California, addressed the Board regarding the closed session item of student discipline. She urged the Board to take alternative measures in lieu of the recommendation for expulsion.

Geraldine M. Perri, Ph.D., Superintendent/President, reported that regular budget updates are being sent to the college community in an effort to keep the college informed. She thanked faculty, staff, and the management team for their work to align the college budget with state funding. Dr. Perri said the state has reduced our base level of funded FTES significantly, forcing us to reduce our instructional program. In addition, due to state reductions in other areas, Citrus has reduced spending in all areas of the institution.

The accreditation self study has been finalized, and Dr. Perri thanked co-chairs, Ms. Roberta Eisel, Student Learning Outcomes Coordinator; Dr. Jeanne Hamilton, Vice President of Student Services; and over 100 faculty, staff, students, and governing board members who have been active in the self study process. She said it is formatted beautifully and reads well.

Dr. Perri said the college's shoulder-to-shoulder effort this last year has positioned us well for our accreditation site visit. Over the past year, we have developed a Fact Book and an Organization and Governance Handbook; reaffirmed our mission statement and defined our college vision and values; and produced a new Educational Master Plan, a new Technology Plan, and an Emergency Preparedness Plan. We have increased the number of courses and programs with SLOs and enhanced the program review process to include all areas of the institution. In addition, over 100 board policies and administrative procedures were revised.

Dr. Perri reported that there will be a special faculty development event for adjunct faculty next week. Adjunct faculty members have also been invited to Convocation. She was pleased to report that the Citrus College Foundation will support Convocation with a \$1,500 donation.

Irene Malmgren, Vice President of Academic Affairs, reported that College Success will hold its second paid Adjunct Workshop as part of Convocation. Regarding our STEM funding, we have just learned that we will receive year-two funding. These additional monies are due to the strength of our STEM program.

In working with our K-12 school districts, Ms. Malmgren said we have replaced microscopes in our science labs, which has allowed us to donate 24 microscopes to Azusa High School and 12 microscopes to Charter Oak High School. In addition,

through our Tech Prep partnership with Azusa Unified School District, we have collaborated on 7 new programs of study that includes 11 career pathways leading to certificates in the college's Career Technical Education programs. We have also collaborated on the upgrade of a Drafting Technology pathway that will keep the program current and qualified to receive Perkins IV Tech Prep funding. Ms. Malmgren congratulated Ms. Marti DeYoung, Career Technical Education Programs Supervisor, and Dr. Kim Holland, Director of Workforce Development, for their work on these programs.

Cosmetology classes have begun, and cosmetology students and faculty will be attending the Foothill Unity Back to School event at Santa Anita Racetrack. They will provide free haircuts, styling, and manicures for K-8 students from low income families.

The Automotive Technology Department was asked by the National Institute for Automotive Service Excellence to be the beta test for a new maintenance and inspection e-learning program this summer. Approximately 60 of our students participated in the four-module test and provided feedback prior to the national launch.

Jeanne Hamilton, Ph.D., Vice President of Student Services, reported that students have been registering for about three weeks, and the college is almost full. She said they are discussing ways to deal with students who may be frustrated by their inability to get into classes.

Dr. Hamilton provided an accreditation update, saying that they have received the list of visiting team members from the commission, and the packages of documents, including the self study, CD, a catalog, and class schedule, will be sent to them. There are two major changes from our last accreditation—the commission's emphasis on evidence and the important role of technology. This year, the self study and almost all of the evidence is available online. Dr. Hamilton credited Ms. Pam McGuern, Administrative Assistant, who undertook the tremendous task of coordinating the self study document and the work of Ms. Jolie Elman, Web Page Specialist, and Ms. Sherrill Paulus, on-call classified employee, for making sure all documents were accessible online. She also thanked Ms. Angie Delgado, Publications Specialist, and Mr. Rocky Reynolds, Reprographics Supervisor, for their work in formatting and printing. Board President Keith thanked everyone for their efforts.

Robert Sammis, J.D., Director of Human Resources, reported that Human Resources held their first annual retreat and it was a good, productive day. They used process mapping to explore possible bottlenecks and areas for improvement in their department. He said the results of their work will flow into written procedures and eventually become an operations manual.

Carol R. Horton, Vice President of Finance and Administrative Services, reported that she attended the annual Budget Workshop conducted by the Chancellor's Office, the Community College League of California, and School Services of California. Regarding the state economy, she said California has gone deeper into recession and our recovery period will be much longer than that of other states. Mrs. Horton said the Legislative Analyst Office has reported that state revenues were less than anticipated by \$900 million in May and June and that the indebtedness of the state is a continuing and growing problem that inhibits the speedy recovery of state finances.

Jack Call, Ph.D., Academic Senate President, said the Academic Senate has not met since the last Board meeting, but he provided a preview of what they will work on beginning in September. The senate will continue working on board policies and administrative procedures, and they plan to look at the sabbatical procedure in detail. They will continue to oversee the program review process, and they will soon have a revised handbook and template posted online, which they worked on over the summer. He and Ms. Eisel will meet regularly with Dr. Perri, Ms. Malmgren, and Dr. Hamilton with the goal of facilitating communication between managers and faculty. In addition, the senate has formed a task force to develop recommendations to the Board of Trustees on department chairs. Dr. Call added that the senate expects that our accreditation will be reaffirmed this year due to the tremendous amount of great work done by the faculty and other campus groups.

Karine Ponce, Student Trustee, said that she attended the 2009 Student Trustee Workshop where she had the opportunity to network with other student trustees. They also received a budget update and discussed some of the major issues affecting community college students.

Regarding ASCC activities, Ms. Ponce said ASCC is planning a retreat in September, and they have also been invited to have breakfast with Dr. Perri.

Joanne Montgomery, Member, Board of Trustees, congratulated Continuing Education on the new format of their program of classes. She also expressed her appreciation to our Cosmetology students, faculty, and staff for their willingness to participate in the Foothill Unity Back to School event.

Patricia Rasmussen, Clerk/Secretary, Board of Trustees, extended a welcome to those who have returned for the fall semester. She congratulated everyone who has worked to secure STEM grant funding. She said our STEM program is a good indication of how well federal funds can be utilized.

Regarding the state economic situation, Dr. Rasmussen said we must deal with the realities and find innovative ways to do things. She encouraged the college community to look beyond “the box” and work together.
