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Highlights of the June 9, 2014, Steering Committee meeting

At the last Steering Committee meeting of the academic year, Dr. Lan Hao led the committee in a review of the Strategic Plan 2013-14 Progress Report, marking the third year of implementation of the Citrus College Strategic Plan for 2011-2016. The Progress Report documents collegewide achievements made towards the five-year plan of advancing institutional goals and strategic objectives in the six key focus areas: Academic Excellence, Student Support and Success, College Resources, Learning Environment, Institutional Effectiveness and Community/College Relations. Dr. Robert Sammis, Director of Human Resources, introduced the new 2013-2018 Human Resources Plan which was established as part of the District's Integrated Planning Model. The Plan is designed to bring together in a uniform planning document the Human Resources goals and objectives outlined in the District's Strategic Plan (2011-2016), the Educational & Facilities Master Plan (2011-2020), the Human Resources Program Review, and the Annual Human Resources Program Review. The Plan establishes long-term and/or ongoing goals in five key areas: 1) Recruitment and Selection; 2) Workforce Excellence; 3) Work Environment; 4) Employer-Employee Relations; and 5) Human Resources Office.

Outgoing ASCC President, Tyler Hernandez, took the opportunity to introduce the new ASCC President, Manuel "Manny" Ramirez, a fine arts major. Mr. Ramirez returns to the board after a semester of service as a senator and also served as president for the final year of the Native American Student Association, and has done much to celebrate and support the students of Native American ancestry at Citrus. He plans to eventually earn a Master's degree and become a curator and museum director. Mr. Ramirez says he is looking forward to joining the Steering Committee in his official capacity at the committee's first meeting of the 2014-2015 academic year on Monday, August 25, 2014.
