- 1. In Fall 2013, fast track English courses have higher success rates compared to traditional English courses. The comparision between English learning community courses and traditional courses show mixed results.
- 2. In Spring 2014, the English learning community courses and fast track courses both have higher success rates than traditional courses.
- 3. In Fall 2014 and Spring 2015, fast track English and math courses have higher success rates compared to regular classes. Learning community English and math courses also have higher success rates compared to regular classes.
