

**Part I: Under-representation of Latino and African American transfers compared to enrollment in the CC system.**

Year 2005, total transfer from 109 community colleges to UC system: 13,241, with Latino students account for **15.4%**, and African American 2.8%. (Data source: Chancellor’s office, MIS)

Year 2005, total transfer from 109 community colleges to CSU system: 52,640, with Latino students account for **23.3%**, and African American 5.4%. (Data source: Chancellor’s office, MIS)

In contrast, in year 2005, Latino students made up of **28.1%** in the total enrollment of community colleges in CA, and African American **7.5%**. See the table below. (Data source: CPEC online data system).
