Citrus College Academic Senate Resolution for Support of Open Educational Resources

WHEREAS, The significant rise in costs of textbooks is a barrier to college attendance, student access, and student success;

WHEREAS, Many colleges are interested in reducing the cost of textbooks to increase student access to necessary course materials; and

WHEREAS, The intent of the College Textbook Affordability Act of 2015 (AB 798, Bonilla, 2015) is to reduce costs for college students by encouraging faculty to accelerate the adoption of lower cost, high-quality, open educational resources (OER);

WHEREAS, Open Educational Resources (OER) offer "high quality teaching and learning resources that have been released under an intellectual property license, such as Creative Commons license, that permits their free use" significantly reducing the expected price of annual textbook costs for students;

RESOLVED, That the Academic Senate of Citrus College support efforts to increase student access to high-quality open educational resources and reduce the cost of textbooks and supplies for students in course sections for which open educational resources are to be adopted to accomplish cost savings for students.
