ENGL 030 Writing Skills I

3 Units

Prerequisite: Placement is based on multiple assessment measures or successful completion of non-credit course work below ENGL 030. Strongly recommended: READ 019 if required by reading placement exam or if required by reading level.

This course focuses intensively on English fundamentals including grammar, spelling, prewriting strategies, and basic paragraph development. This course is designed primarily for those students preparing for ENGL 040. 54 lecture hours, 14 lab hours arranged.

3 Units

A course for intermediate English language students providing additional practice in the four language skills--listening, speaking, reading and writing. Emphasis on vocabulary building, developing fluency in speaking, increasing written sentence complexity and developing reading skills. One of three core courses in ESL Level 3 54 lecture hours. 9 lab hours arranged.
