CIS 099 Introduction to Windows and Personal Computers 2 Units

This course provides comprehensive instruction in the use of spreadsheet software to create, edit, store, retrieve, and print spreadsheets and charts. Topics include completing calculations, making decisions, organizing and graphing data, developing professional looking reports, publishing organized data to the Web, and accessing real-time data from Web sites. 54 lecture hours.
