

Hello Math 130 Students,

You are receiving this email because you have enrolled in Math 130 Crn #20833.

This course is mostly online with the exceptions of coming to Citrus College to take 5 exams and the final exam. This class needs a major commitment on your part – it requires you to read the book (**the class is not designed for students who do not read the book**), understand the chapter content, do homework and take quizzes on-line and on your own. Although the minimum requirement is completion of Math 029 with C or better, I recommend that only students with an A or B in the previous class take this course. To get started, log in to www.coursecompass.com and use **my temporary** username “medranotemp” with password “fall2011”. Click the link “Math 130 (Fall 2011)”

On the left column you have tabs such as “Announcements”, “Course information”, “Staff Information”, etc... Before the class begins, please read and fully understand the “syllabus” and the “suggested schedule”. Also, browse through the rest of the links and get comfortable with the format of the course

Under the “Homework Tab”, the homework has been posted for the entire semester” pay close attention to the due dates. **No extensions will be granted under any circumstances.** By clicking “Quizzes and Tests” you will find all quizzes posted already. Another useful tab is “ebook”. This tab provides you with an electronic copy of the book. Again, browse through the tab/link to get comfortable.

I have attached the syllabus and the suggested schedule, if you decide to keep the course, please be advised there will be no extensions for any assignments. You are required to purchase the book with the code or the code to create your own coursecompass account. You may purchase the book with the code at the bookstore or you may purchase the code by going to www.coursecompass.com and select “register” under “student”, the course id is “**Medrano38647**” You must create the account no later than September 10th – homework #1 and quiz # 1 are due on September 1st.

Finally, I will not use blackboard for this course. We will only use coursecompass.com
