

CITRUS COMMUNITY COLLEGE SPORTS VENUE RULES

1.	No	aum	or	sunflower	seeds.

- 2. No food or drinks (Sideline hydration fluids are allowed. Leftover fluids may not be dumped on the turf. Use gutter drains on the outside of the track.)
- 3. No pets.
- No smoking, open flame, barbecues or fireworks on campus grounds.
- No alcoholic beverages on campus.
- 6. No glass containers.
- 7. No digging in turf or driving stakes into surface.
- 8. No vehicles on turf or track surfaces.
- 9. No bikes, skateboards, roller blades, scooters or skates.
- 10. No paint, chalk, permanent markings.
- 11. No tape on field surface.
- 12. No climbing on goal posts or surrounding fences.
- No spectators allowed on track or turf.
- 14. No aircraft or airborne operations other than emergencies.
- 15. At least one coach must be present at all practices and games.
- 16. For football games, each team will be allowed a maximum of 15 individuals on the sidelines other than players and coaches.
- 17. The Press box is for use by coaches and the media only. Professional conduct must be maintained in the Press box at all times.
- 18. Parking: A valid parking permit is required for all vehicles parked on campus at all times, 24 hours per day/7 days per week/365 days per year. All vehicles must park within a designated parking stall and must park facing into the stall (head-in-parking only). Parking permits can be purchased from any Automated Pay Station (APS) machine located in the S1, S2, S3, S4, S5, S6, S8 or S9 parking lots. For the convenience of your event participants, an advance reservation of pre-purchased parking permits, for a pre-determined number of individual parking stalls or for an entire lot(s), may be arranged in advance of the event, through the Facility Rental Supervisor and in coordination with the Director of Campus Safety. For a full text of parking regulations, please refer to the Citrus Community College District Administrative Procedure on Parking (AP 6750), which can be found on the District's website.
- 19. Each team shall furnish sufficient support staff to enforce the above rules both in the venue and the parking lots.
- 20. Any bodily fluids, such as blood or vomit, must be cleaned up immediately by the team trainer. See the attendant for biohazard clean-up kits and instructions for their use.
- 21. For events, stages or other large structures erected on the turf must be set on minimum 161x161x11/211base pads.
- 22. For graduations and other similar ceremonies, only chairs, tables and similar items with blunt leg tips or slip-on protective leg tips will be allowed on the turf.
- 23. For track meets and practices, the stadium turf area may not be used as a team assembly or rest area no pop-ups, tents, blankets, etc.
