Together, these 2 databases offer over 4600 full text periodicals (some from 1985), plus over a 1000 more indexed only.

1. From the library's Home Page, www.citruscollege.edu/library
2. Click on **EBSCO** under **Quick Links**
3. From home: User Name: **citruscc** Password: **library**.
4. Scroll down to add other databases: **History Reference Center & Magill on History**
5. Click **Continue**, at the bottom or top of the screen, or press **Enter**.
6. Use the following example to design the search strategy.
7. To e-mail an article, select the article's full text form, and then click the e-mail button at the top or bottom of the article.

1. Use Library of Congress subject headings (without dashes). (See below.)
2. Use ? to replace one letter.
3. Use singular nouns; EBSCO will search for both singular and plural forms.
4. Use * for all forms of a word. (Work* = working, workers, worked...)
5. Use TX All Text to get more hits.
6. Use "or" between synonyms in the same search window.
7. Click the box for Full Text to get more results.

5. Enter search terms & dates, if needed.
6. Use language of the times: Negro or colored, not African American.

Timelines

1. Click on "View Publications" by History.
2. Scroll down to "American Decades" or "People's Chronology."
3. Click "Within this publication" and enter search words.
4. Careful to click the browser's back button to re-enter search terms in that single publication.

Under Browse by Topic , click on a topic. Enter keywords . Select Gallery View for images. Or scroll up to click on Browse a list of subject headings . Select a subject heading and view the documents. Don't use quotations marks.

U.S. History (WWW-VL) http://vlib.iue.it/history/USA/	The Virtual Library with links by topics or timeline, or keyword search. Maintained by a retired history professor from U Kansas.
