

Facilities Update: FYI

A large chiller unit, the heart of the campus central plant, is down due to a failed motor. The central plant provides chilled water for comfort cooling in approximately 75% of the buildings on campus, and the repairs are expected to take from 4 to 6 weeks.

Currently, a smaller back-up chiller unit is in operation, but this unit will only keep up if the weather remains mild. Consequently, if the weather turns warm it is likely that some buildings will experience higher than normal room temperatures.

The facilities department is doing everything it can to expedite repairs, but rebuilding the failed motor will take some time. We ask your patience and understanding.
