

Fire Drill To Be Conducted This Month

As part of Citrus College's ongoing emergency preparation, an all-campus fire drill has been planned. All faculty are being asked to review evacuation procedures with their classes that meet from 9:55 a.m. to 11:20 a.m., prior to Wednesday, September 23. Emergency flip charts should be posted in all classrooms. The goal of the fire drill is to train all students in proper evacuation protocol and to practice the actual drill in two randomly-selected campus buildings on September 23. Proactive Measures for a Safe Semester

Citrus College is committed to providing a safe environment that supports learning. Our success in achieving this depends on each of us taking responsibility for our personal safety. As we begin the third week of the fall semester, I would like to remind you of some proactive measures to ensure your safety and well-being, on and off campus.

In addition to their 24-hour presence on campus, the Security Office provides assistance including vehicle jump-starts, vehicle unlocks, and a security escort. The security escort is available on campus, from dusk to dawn. Please note that during busy periods, callers may experience a 10-minute delay in the arrival of the officer.

- Always be aware of your surroundings.
- Lock your vehicle; do not leave your valuables and other personal belongings where they can be seen.
- Keep track of your wallet or backpack when you are in class, the library, a lab or other campus areas.
- At night, walk in well-lighted areas, preferably with a friend.
- Tell your family or friends where you are going, what time you will arrive, and what time you will return home.
- Report any illegal or suspicious behavior to the Security Office, 626-914-8611, or extension 8611 if you are calling from a campus phone. If you are calling from a campus pay phone, you can reach Security by pressing *11.
