The Writing Café

The Writing Café had a very successful summer pilot! During the six-week summer session, writing consultants conducted 175 consultations with students from across all disciplines. Now we look forward to continuing and expanding The Writing Café this fall, adding reading discussion groups, guest speakers, essay contests, and more!

Students wanting writing assistance may come to the Writing Café in the College Success Center (ED 224), with work from any class. Support from trained writing consultants is available at every stage in the writing process. Writing consultation appointments are 30 minutes, and students are limited to two 30-minute appointments per week. Additional consultations are available on a walk-in basis. No instructor referral is needed.

Campus Safety Dedication

Save the date! The new Citrus College Campus Safety Building will be dedicated this fall. The 2,000 square foot structure features safety offices, a drive-up

window, staff and visitor parking areas, and a finger-printing section. This new facility cost \$1,219,000 and was funded by the Measure G Bond passed by voters in 2004. The building dedication celebration will take place on **Tuesday, November 16 at 3 p.m.**
