Summer Work Schedule

There will be a four-day work-week for nine weeks during the summer months. Between the weeks of Monday, June 20, 2011 and Monday, August 15, 2011, college offices will be closed on Fridays. The summer work schedule will be Monday through Thursday, with offices being open from 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. Employees who work 100 percent will work four ten-hour days per week; those who work 75 percent will work four 7-hour, 30 minute days; 69 percent employees will work four 6-hour, 40 minute days; 49 percent employees will work 19-hour, 36 minute work-weeks; and 40 percent employees will work 16-hour work weeks. - Congratulations to the students of the Citrus College *Clarion* Newspaper. They recently attended the 56th annual state convention of the Journalism Association of Community Colleges in Sacramento on April 7 through April 10, 2011. At the convention, 45 community colleges were represented by 550 student delegates and 40 faculty advisers. Students had the opportunity to compete in 13 on-the-spot competitions and chose between 70 workshops presented by media professionals. The Citrus College team brought home the coveted General Excellence award, as well as three individual on-the-spot and seven individual mail-in category awards.
