Once every ten years, each California community college district that elects its board of trustees "by trustee area" is required to adjust its trustee area plan (Education Code 5019.5). The Citrus Community College District will be holding a Public Redistricting Forum on Tuesday, June 21, 2011 at 6 p.m. in the Center for Innovation, Room 159. Members of the community are urged to attend this public forum in order to provide their input and testimony regarding revisions to the District's trustee area plan. The Community College League of California and Redistricting Partners will conduct the forum, which is hosted by the Citrus Community College District Board of Trustees and Superintendent/President Geraldine M. Summer Workweek

There will be a four-day workweek for nine weeks during the summer months. Between Monday, June 20, 2011 and Monday, August 15, 2011, college offices will be closed on Fridays. The summer work schedule will be Monday through Thursday, with offices being open from 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. Employees who work 100 percent will work four ten-hour days per week; those who work 75 percent will work four 7 hour, 30 minute days; 69 percent employees will work 6-hour, 40 minute days; 49 percent employees will work 19-hour, 36 minute workweeks; and 40 percent employees will work 16-hour work weeks. No deduction from vacation time will be made for the Fourth of July holiday, with employees receiving 10 hours of holiday pay.
