The fall sports teams at Citrus College are making headlines! The Women's soccer team continued the strong start to their 2012 season with a 1-0 win at Oxnard College last week. The win closed up an unblemished pre-conference schedule for the Owls for the second time in program history.

The football team has also had considerable success. Their victory over Grossmont College on Saturday, September 15 moved them up to number 4 in the California Poll and number 11 in the State Poll. And while they lost to number 1 ranked Mt. SAC on September 21, their record is still an impressive 3-1.

Freshmen Michael Tejada and Marilyn Meza have emerged as team standouts after they participated in the annual Southern California Preview at Fairview Park in Costa Mesa.
