- Optional tours explore the great cities and historic sites of Europe.

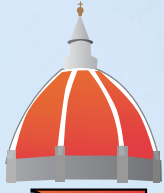

Earn 6 units of CSU/UC transferable credit:

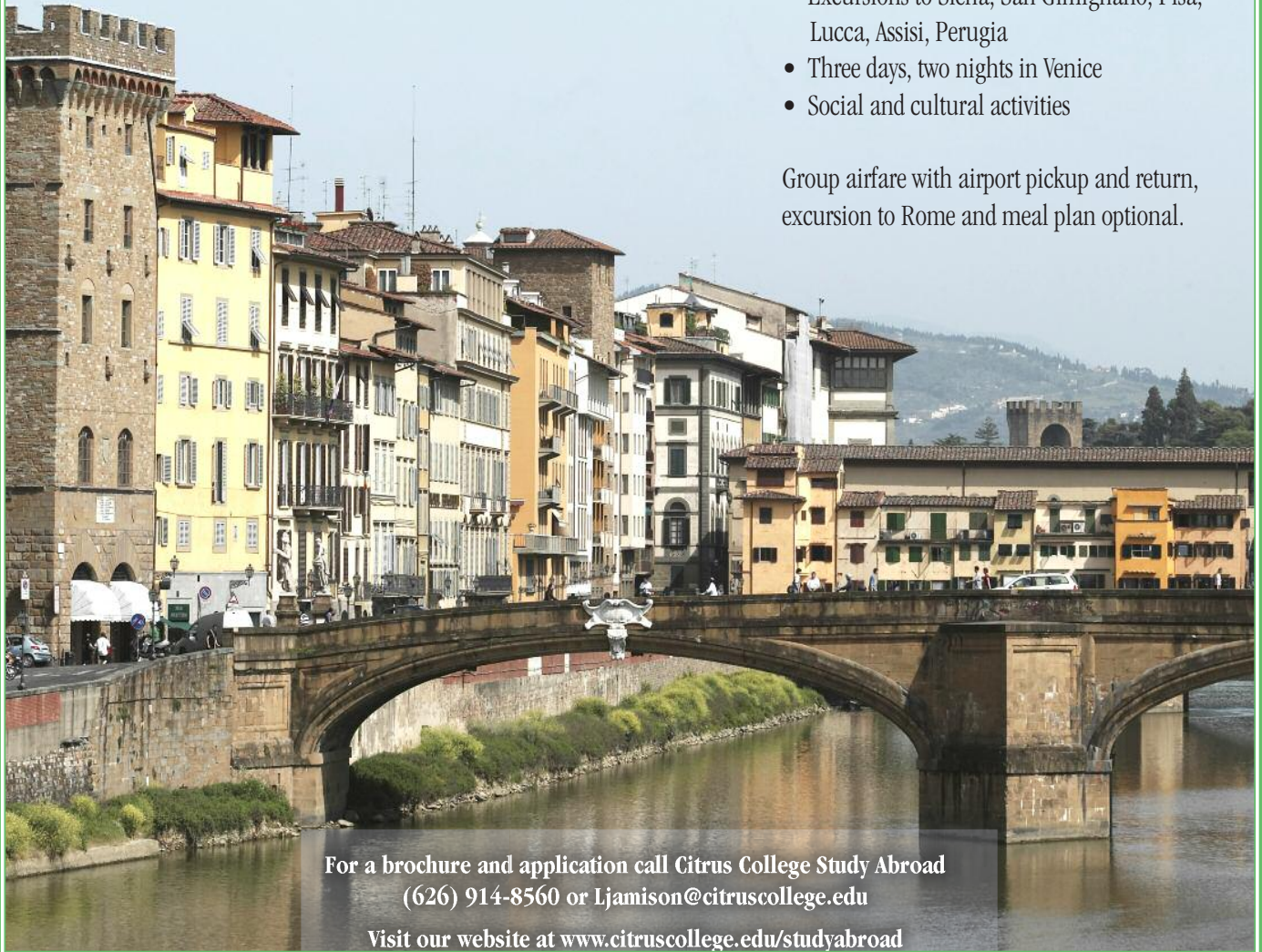
History 103 – History of World Civilization to 1500
