



## 2017 - 2018 FINANCIAL AID STUDENT BUDGETS (Cost of Attendance)

The following standard student budgets (Cost of Attendance) have been accepted for the use of the college in determining student's *financial need*.

Cost of Attendance **minus** Expected Family Contribution (EFC) equals *financial need*.

Once a student meets all the eligibility requirements for financial aid, the Financial Aid Office will determine how much financial aid a student can receive based on a student's *financial need* and the availability of funds.
