SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Attach unofficial or official college transcripts indicating 12 units completed with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better.
- 2. Must be currently attending a member college (listed below).
- 3. Write a 500-word essay explaining:
- · Why you want to participate in the Rome program.
- · How the program meets your personal, academic, and professional goals.
- · How you will promote study abroad during your program and when you return to your home college (or after transfer).
- 4. Provide a letter of recommendation from a college professor who has directly observed your recent, successful academic performance in a college level class. The recommendation letter must detail your specific contributions to the class, leadership abilities, and any other qualifying information that supports your candidacy for this award.

*Students receiving the AIFS Scholarships are agreeing to attend a study abroad info meeting upon their return and work with AIFS student advisors on-site during the semester to gather pictures and video, and write a blog sharing their experiences abroad with other students through AIFS and SCFC social networking sites.

Selection will be based upon previous academic achievement and strength of statement.
