LICENSED VOCATIONAL NURSING PROGRAM INFORMATION

This program conforms to the California Board of Vocational Nursing and Psychiatric Technicians (BVNPT). Successful completion of the Citrus College Licensed Vocational Nursing (LVN) program qualifies students for examination for licensure as a vocational nurse in the state of California. After general college admission criteria are satisfied, the health sciences department requires:

1. **Proof of U.S. high school graduation or the equivalent.**
2. **Successful completion of the NRS 100 – Introduction to Vocational Nursing course at Citrus College.**

*This course is graded on a pass/no pass (P/NP) basis only. Only those students selected for the LVN program receive a pass (P) grade. Only the top-scoring students across all sections of NRS 100 are selected to fill the available spaces in the LVN program. Students not selected for the program are given a no pass (NP) grade in the course. Eligibility for admission to the LVN program pertains **only** to the following semester.*

3. **The student must attend the mandatory orientation.**
