## **BP 2745 BOARD SELF-EVALUATION**

The Board of Trustees is committed to assessing its own performance as a Board in order to identify its strengths and areas in which it may improve its functioning.

To that end, the Board of Trustees has established the following processes:

The Board may establish a standing committee to meet periodically throughout the year to assist the Board of Trustees in developing its self-evaluation and evaluation instrument. The standing committee will consist of the President and the Vice President of the Board of Trustees. The standing committee will meet in compliance with Board Policy 2220. The Board self-evaluation shall occur during the month of July. Any evaluation instrument shall incorporate criteria contained in these Board Policies regarding Board operations, as well as criteria defining Board effectiveness promulgated by recognized practitioners in the field.

If an instrument is used, all Board members will be asked to complete the evaluation instrument and submit it to the Superintendent/President's Office to tabulate a summary of the evaluations.

A summary of the evaluations will be presented and discussed at a Board session scheduled for that purpose. The results will be used to identify accomplishments in the past year and goals for the following year.
