Throughout the spring semester, I have enjoyed meeting with so many of you, our campus community members. With each interaction, I am reminded of how special Citrus College is and the important role you play in the lives of our students. As we prepare for spring break, I wanted to take a moment to thank you and share a few important updates.

Enrollment

I am thrilled to report that our enrollment continues to climb each day. As of Thursday, April 13, our unduplicated headcount enrollment is 9,878 students. Our spring 2023 projected number of full-time equivalent students (FTES) is currently at 3,348, compared to 3,157 in spring 2022, which is an increase of approximately 6% over last spring. This extraordinary achievement would not be possible without the efforts of each of you - our dedicated faculty and staff. Thank you for supporting our students every day as we work together to build our enrollment back toward pre-pandemic levels.

Commencement

On March 21, the Citrus Community College District Board of Trustees approved revisions to the 2022-2023 academic calendar as recommended by our campus governance committees, which included moving commencement to **Friday, June 16, at 6 p.m.** I am looking forward to celebrating our amazing students with our campus community, our students and their families, on a new date and time.

If your schedule permits, I hope to see you at our upcoming Tenured Faculty and Retirees Reception in the Campus Center on Tuesday, May 16, at 3:30 p.m. before the board meeting. We will celebrate five faculty members receiving tenure and recognize the retirement of 14 faculty and staff, as well as thank them for their dedicated service to Citrus College.
