

Summary Results of ENGL101 Writing Center Reports Fall 2018 through Fall 2019

Introduction

The purpose of this report is to summarize the results of the Writing Center Reports from Fall 2018, Spring 2019, and Fall 2019. These reports explore students' use of the Writing Center's (WC) services, as well as its effectiveness, for students enrolled in *Reading and Composition with Support – ENGL101+101S* – with an Embedded Tutor (ET) versus without.

Writing Center Usage

Among the students that went to the Writing Center at least once, **those in ET classes had _____ visits on average compared to students in non-ET classes.**

Demographics of Writing Center attendees

With the exception of Spring 2019, **female students visited the Writing Center at a higher proportion than males**, regardless of whether they were enrolled in ENGL101 with or without embedded tutoring.
