

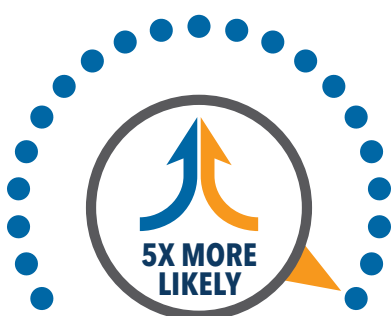

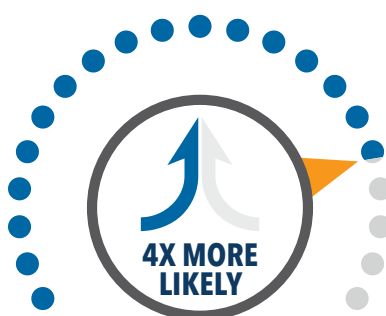

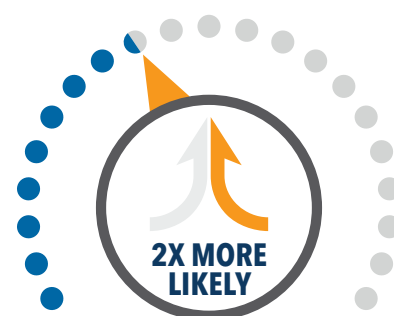
WHAT IS THE LIKELIHOOD OF STUDENTS TRANSFERRING?

ENGLISH ONLY

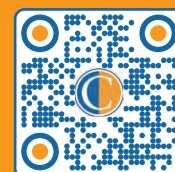

DID YOU KNOW?

FACT: Citrus College students who complete transfer-level math and English courses during their first year are five-times more likely to transfer to a four-year university within three years.

WHAT IS THE LIKELIHOOD OF STUDENTS TRANSFERRING?

- Completing transfer-level math and English: Five times more likely
- Completing transfer-level math only: Four times more likely
- Completing transfer-level English only: Two times more likely
