RE: Fall 2023 Student Parking Permits

The following is an important parking update regarding **fall 2023 parking permits**. As a friendly reminder, <u>parking permits are required in all campus parking lots</u>, at all times.

• Fall 2023 parking permits will go on sale <u>Monday, August 14, 2023</u> and will be required for the fall semester <u>on Tuesday, September 5, 2023.</u>

- Fall permits will be \$70 or \$50 for California College Promise Grant (CCPG) students and can be purchased online at the <u>iParq</u> website:
 - o <u>https://citruscollege.thepermitstore.com/</u>
- Semester/intersession parking permits are "virtual."
 - No physical semester parking permit will be mailed to you.
 - No temporary parking permit will need to be printed.
 - No physical permit will need to be affixed to the front windshield of your vehicle.
 - The vehicle license plate you register when purchasing your parking permit will act as your "virtual" parking permit.
- Please enter the correct license plate number of your vehicle when ordering your permit and link the vehicle to your current permit to avoid receiving a citation.
- Once a permit is ordered online, your permit is activated immediately and will be valid the first day of the fall semester which begins on August 28, 2023.

How To Order Your New Permit:

Current students who have previously ordered a permit:

If you already created an iParq account when you initially ordered a previous parking permit, log onto your existing iParq account by entering the username and password you created in the <u>upper</u> <u>right corner</u> of the website.

New students who have never ordered a permit:

If you are a new student and have never created an iParq account or if this is your first time ordering a parking permit via iParq, log onto iParq by clicking on the web link above. Then click on the "Buy Permits" image, enter your Citrus email - only up to the @ symbol, all lower case (example: jdoe) and the last 4 digits of your Citrus College (Wingspan) I.D. number, in the <u>middle</u> of the website. If you do not know your Citrus I.D. number, please login to your Wingspan account or contact the TeCS help desk at (626) 857-4100 and they will provide it to you.

You will then be asked to register your vehicle(s). While up to two vehicles can be actively registered on your account, **both vehicles cannot be parked on campus at the same time**. It is your responsibility to enter the correct license plate number of your vehicle(s). **Incorrect license plate numbers or vehicles not registered/linked to a valid permit will be cited.** When ordering your permit, please ensure all your contact information is up to date and accurate. **Parking permit accounts, credentials, or virtual permits may not be shared.**

As a friendly reminder,

- Student parking permits are <u>ordered each semester/intersession</u> and are only valid for that specific semester/intersession
- Student permits are <u>not</u> valid in employee, client, district vehicle or metered parking stalls
- All vehicles parked on campus must have a valid parking permit at all times
- For your safety, all vehicles must be parked facing into the stall; head-in-parking only
- Motorcycles must have a <u>valid motorcycle permit</u> and must be parked in a designated motorcycle parking area, not in a vehicle parking stall
- There is no overnight parking on campus
- Failure to abide by any of the above will result in a citation with a minimum of \$35 per violation
- For a full text of the campus parking and traffic regulations, see <u>AP 6750.</u>
