Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Is there a student graduation rehearsal?

A: No. However, our team prepared [a five minute YouTube video](#) to help you prepare and know what to expect on graduation day. Please review these instructions carefully.

Q: Are tickets required for my friends and family?

A: Tickets are not required. Our stadium has plenty of seating available and parking is free. Guests should arrive early and [park in lot S6](#). We will also livestream the ceremony on the college's [YouTube channel](#) and [Facebook page](#).

Q: What are the COVID safety requirements for Commencement at Citrus College?

A: Citrus College will adhere to Los Angeles County Department of Public Health's Guidelines for higher education institutions. Graduates and guests are encouraged, but not required to wear masks. Anyone who is experiencing COVID related symptoms, including their guests, must remain at home and can celebrate commencement via the livestream on [our YouTube channel](#) and [Facebook page](#).

Free testing is available for all graduates attending the ceremony. The testing site is located at the Haugh Performing Arts Center during the following hours for the week of June 13, 2022 leading up to graduation. **It is expected that all graduating students will be tested and have a negative result in order to participate in commencement.**

Tuesday, June 14: 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Wednesday, June 15: 7:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 3 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Thursday, June 16: 7:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 3 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Friday, June 17: 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Q: What time do I need to arrive?

A: Check in begins at 7:45 a.m. Please arrive and check in by 8 a.m. The ceremony begins promptly at 9 a.m. Spiked heels are **NOT allowed**, as they damage the stadium turf and all-weather track. Platform shoes are an acceptable alternative. Proper footwear is required to participate in commencement.
