Dear Citrus College Students,

As you begin to plan for your winter and spring classes, I wanted to let you know that **Citrus College will** continue to deliver a majority of classes and support services in a remote/online format through the spring 2021 semester.

A limited number of students and faculty will be allowed on campus to resume in-person instruction in programs that are considered essential by the county and state, such as nursing, registered dental assistant, automotive technology, and medium and heavy-duty truck technology.

This decision was made in accordance with the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health (Public Health) and Governor Newsom's Blueprint for a Safer Economy, in which LA County remains in the "widespread" tier due to the number of new daily cases and positive test rates. The college will continue to rely on the guidelines from Public Health to determine when it is safe to fully reopen.

Your health and safety, along with the wellbeing of our faculty, staff and the community remain our top priority. This year has been challenging for all of us, but I want to reassure you that we are here to help you reach your academic goals.
