

*COVID-19 ON CAMPUS PROTOCOLS, INCLUDING MANDATORY TESTING*



We hope your semester is off to a great start. To all of our students, whether you are taking classes online, on-campus or both, please know how grateful we are that you are pursuing your education at Citrus College. For those of you attending classes on campus, a few reminders to help make the testing and screening process as smooth as possible:

## 1. CITRUS MOBILE APP



Please make sure you have downloaded the Citrus College Mobile App to your smartphone.

## 2. DAILY PRE-SCREENING



Prior to your arrival on campus, please click on the owl icon “Daily Pre-Screening” and answer all of the questions. If you get a red pass by mistake, please go to the COVID-19 testing site and someone will be able to clear your pass.

A few recommendations:

- Read the questions completely.
- Do not hit the submit button until you are sure you answered the questions correctly (you can use the back arrow at the top of the page to go back).
- If you have some symptoms, but know the symptoms are not related to COVID-19, for example a runny nose that you know is from an allergy, you do not need to indicate that symptom on the related question.
- If you need to retrieve your pass, for example to enter a classroom, simply go the bottom of the app screen and click on the person icon. Then click on “Health and Wellness” and then click on “My Campus Pass.” This will bring up your pass for the day.

And most importantly:

- You may answer yes to the question asking, “Do you affirm that you will complete your weekly required COVID-19?” if you are on your way to the on-campus COVID-19 testing center or in line to get tested (Note: effective March 1, 2022, this question has been modified to state “will” complete).

### 4. **MASKS**



Masks are required at all times while indoors and while in line at the on-campus COVID-19 testing center. Following recent reports of county and statewide mask requirement changes, the College is evaluating the current mask requirement and will provide communication in the future regarding the mask requirement that is currently in place at the College, and any changes to our safety protocols.

While it is a relief to know that the county's COVID-19 positivity rates, number of cases, deaths and hospitalizations are declining, it is imperative that we continue to do everything we can to limit the potential spread of COVID-19 cases on campus. In consultation with various campus leaders and advice from our team of medical experts, the Citrus College indoor mask requirement will remain in place at this time. As such, all students, employees, and members of the public must continue to wear an appropriate medical grade mask while inside any college building or facility. Citrus College will continue to closely monitor the status of the pandemic, and will communicate any changes to our safety protocols as appropriate in the future.
