Connect

Talk to professors in subjects that interest you.

Job shadow and conduct informational interviews with professionals in the fields you are considering.

Explore

Take an introductory class in a subject that interests you.

Sign up for a career course and learn about your interests, strengths, skills, and personality to help narrow down your options.

Experience

Join a student club on campus.

Volunteer with an organization.

Apply for an internship or job related to your career of interest.

Consult

Visit Citrus College Career/Transfer Center (CTC) to schedule an appointment with a career counselor.

Research

Learn about job duties, employment outlook, and more.

Read publications/blogs and subscribe to social media feeds related to your career of interest.
