



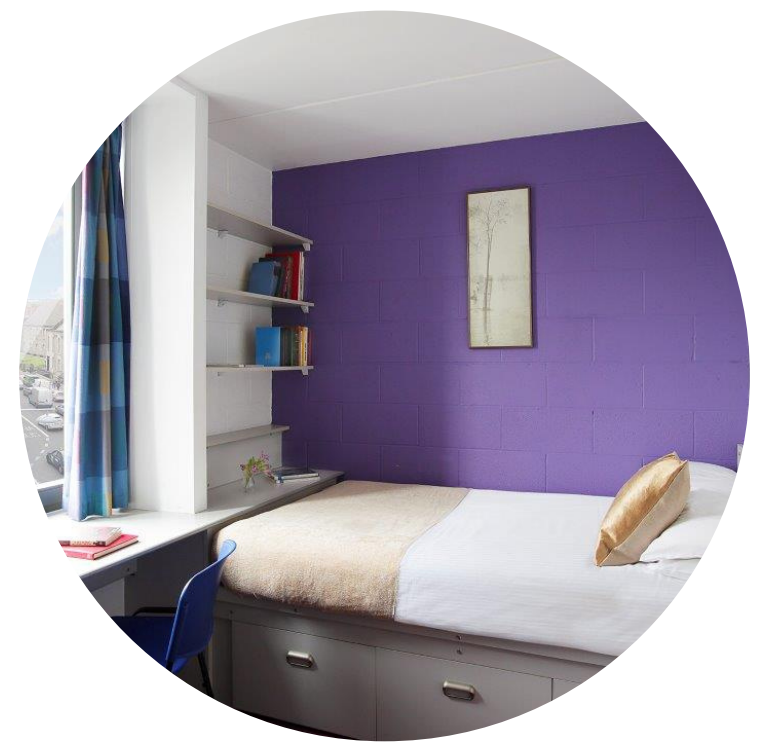

We know you aren't going to want to be spending a lot of time in your apartment during the brief time you have in Dublin, but it is important to have a safe and comfortable place to call home while abroad. Your accommodation at Trinity College Dublin will be fully-furnished, self-catering student apartments, which will provide a home away from home right in the heart of Dublin city centre!

What is included?

- Single bedded rooms, with wardrobes/closets (4-7 rooms per apartment)
- Shared kitchen/living room with microwave, fridge, oven/stove, pots and pans and all crockery & cutlery
- Shared bathroom with a shower (minimum of 2 bathrooms per apartment)
- Bedding pack - pillows, sheets, comforter
- All bills and WiFi
- Weekly cleaning service
- Laundry services on campus
- 24-hour security and key/ID card for entrance to campus after hours
- Services of the accommodations staff, should you have any urgent questions



What is NOT included?

- Toiletries, toilet paper*, towels, food items, and cleaning products (*provided on arrival but not replenished)
- Meals* or groceries (*unless breakfast is included in your program fee)
- Please have all mail sent c/o AIFS at the accommodation offices
- Any damages will have to be paid for



What is nearby?

On-campus eateries and lots of other cafes, restaurants and pubs
Grocery stores, Pharmacies, ATMs, Print shop and on-campus gym (fee applies)
Almost all tourist attractions, museums and sites within walking distance including Temple Bar, Grafton Street, O'Connell Street and more!
