SUMMER 2024 PRAGUE APPLICATION TIMELINE

The summer intersession in Prague, Czech Republic program is <u>open to all college students</u>. Eligibility requires a cumulative GPA of 2.5 and completion of about 12 college level units. If it is your first semester, we will accept a progress report. Undergraduate students from outside colleges may submit unofficial college transcripts. **Student must be 18 years old by the arrival date**.

(Step 1) Contact the study abroad office **OR** go to Citrus College's study abroad website and complete the <u>Interest Form</u>. (Step 2) Once this is completed and approved, your advisor will you send you a link to the **AIFS online enrollment** form. After completing this form, the (Step 3) payment of the \$450 deposit will secure your place in the program. If you are not a Citrus student, you will need to apply for admission.

\$450 deposit DEADLINE: Pay the \$450 deposit by **April 5, 2024**. The complete balance of payments is due May 10, 2024. Please see the Fee Schedule information sheet below for more detail.

FINANCIAL AID

Pell eligible students may receive up to 50% of their semester award during if they enroll in a minimum of 6 units. See the <u>Summer 2024 Disbursement and Refund Schedule</u> for more information. Additionally, students may be eligible for the tuition waiver during the summer intersession.

REGISTRATION FOR CLASSES

Once you have paid the deposit, you will be able to register through <u>Citrus' Wingspan student portal</u> on your designated registration date. If students are not eligible for the Promise Grant (formerly BOGW), tuition fees will be applied (3 units x \$46 = \$138 per course).

Citrus College Prague Program Summer 2024



The AIFS program based on an enrollment of 25-29 participants is: \$3,495 and includes the following:

Transfers, Accommodation and Meals:

- One-time round-trip group transfer by private bus between the airport in Prague (PRG) and the student housing at an agreed meeting time for the group on the scheduled arrival and departure date.
- Accommodation in twin-bedded rooms in a centrally located student residence with shared kitchen and laundry facilities on-site. Linens and towels, weekly cleaning, and Wi-Fi
- Self-catering facilities at student accommodation, a welcome dinner, a farewell dinner, and occasional meals on excursions.

Travel pass:

• Travel pass for unlimited use on the metro, buses, and trams in the central zone of Prague for the duration of the program.

Academic Support and Cultural Activities:

- An orientation program in Prague consisting of a meeting with experienced AIFS staff, includes information on acclimation to Prague, cultural differences, safety and security, and a local area walking tour.
- A half-day guided sightseeing tour of Prague with services of an English-speaking guide.
- A full-day excursion by private bus to Kutna Hora, including entrances to St Barbora Cathedral, silver mines, and bone church Sedlec.
- A full-day excursion by private bus to Terezin and Lidice Memorial, including all entrance fees and a professional English-speaking guide throughout.
- A full-day excursion by private bus to Bohemian Switzerland National Park, including a group lunch.
 A full-day excursion from Prague to Dresden by train, round-way tickets, reserved seating in standard class, including a walking tour in Dresden with the services of a professional English-speaking guide, entrance to the Green Vault Museum and free time for exploration.

Also Included:

- Access to a team of dedicated AIFS Student Services staff for information, personal advising/counseling, and 24-hour emergency contact service
- Medical insurance policy

Program does not include the following:

- Round-trip airfare
- Textbooks
- Citrus College tuition and/or administrative fees

Refund policy and important dates to remember should you need to cancel your participation:

on or before Friday, May 10, 2024	All fees paid less the \$450 deposit and any non-refundable deposits paid by the participant or by AIFS on the participant's behalf will be refunded.
Withdrawing after Friday, May 10, 2024	No refund and the total program fee is due.

Please note that after the final payment deadline the full program fee is due to AIFS even if you have not yet paid and do not participate or plan to participate in the program. Non-refundable financial commitments have been made to secure your spot. If a participant withdraws once the program has begun, there is no refund. This refund policy applies whether a participant pays AIFS Abroad directly for all, part, or no program fees.
