The multiple measures placement decision rule sets are based on the May $18^{\text {th }}, 2016$ version of the statewide guideline. Some local interpretations of the rule sets were made for the purpose of understanding the possible placement scenarios. These interpretations are subject to change pending new release of the rule sets and further discussions with faculty and counselors.

- Students are placed at the highest possible level based on the statewide guideline.
- Some students have a cumulative GPA as of completion of high school but some have a cumulative GPA as of completion of $11^{\text {th }}$ grade or first semester of $12^{\text {th }}$ grade. In this report, all students are considered direct matriculants regardless of their GPA time stamp.
- "Pass" means grades $\mathrm{A}+, \mathrm{A}, \mathrm{A}-, \mathrm{B}+, \mathrm{B}, \mathrm{B}-, \mathrm{C}+$ and C . Grades $\mathrm{C}-, \mathrm{D}+, \mathrm{D}, \mathrm{D}-, \mathrm{F}$ are not considered pass.
- High school transcripts are rounded to one decimal place.
- Students taking ESL placement tests are temporarily included in the English table due to the small sample size.
