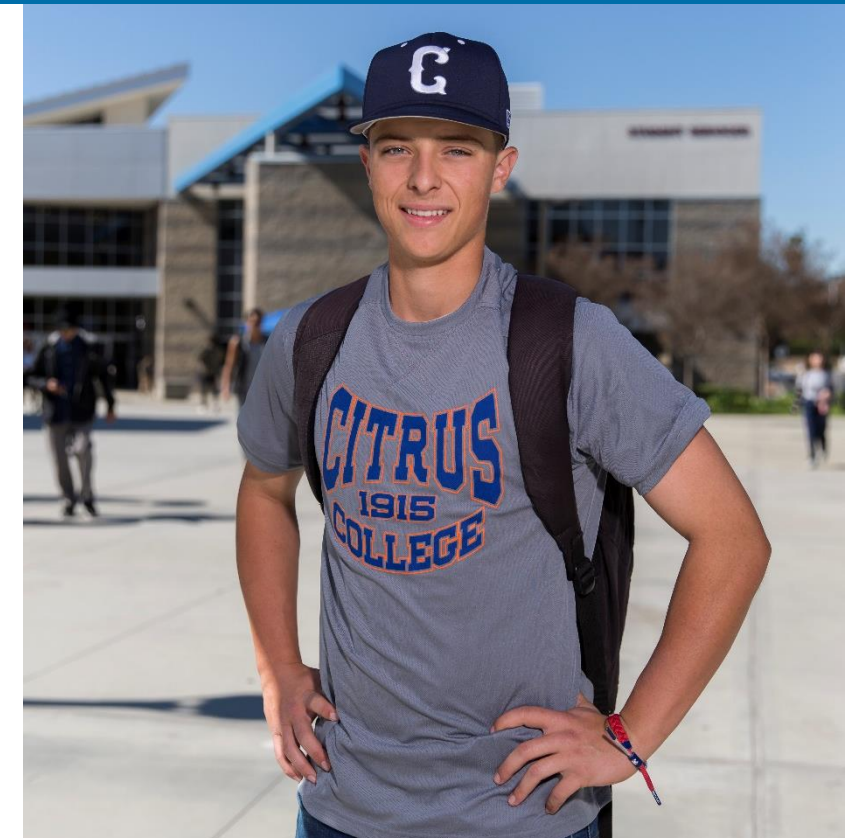
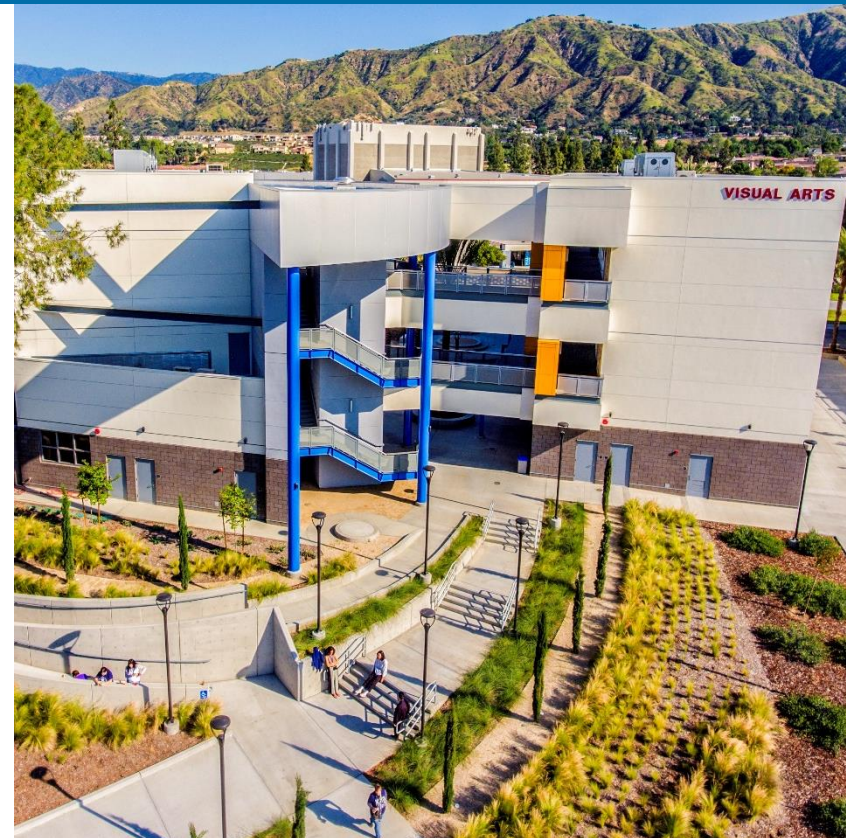

## Focus Area 6: Safe Environment

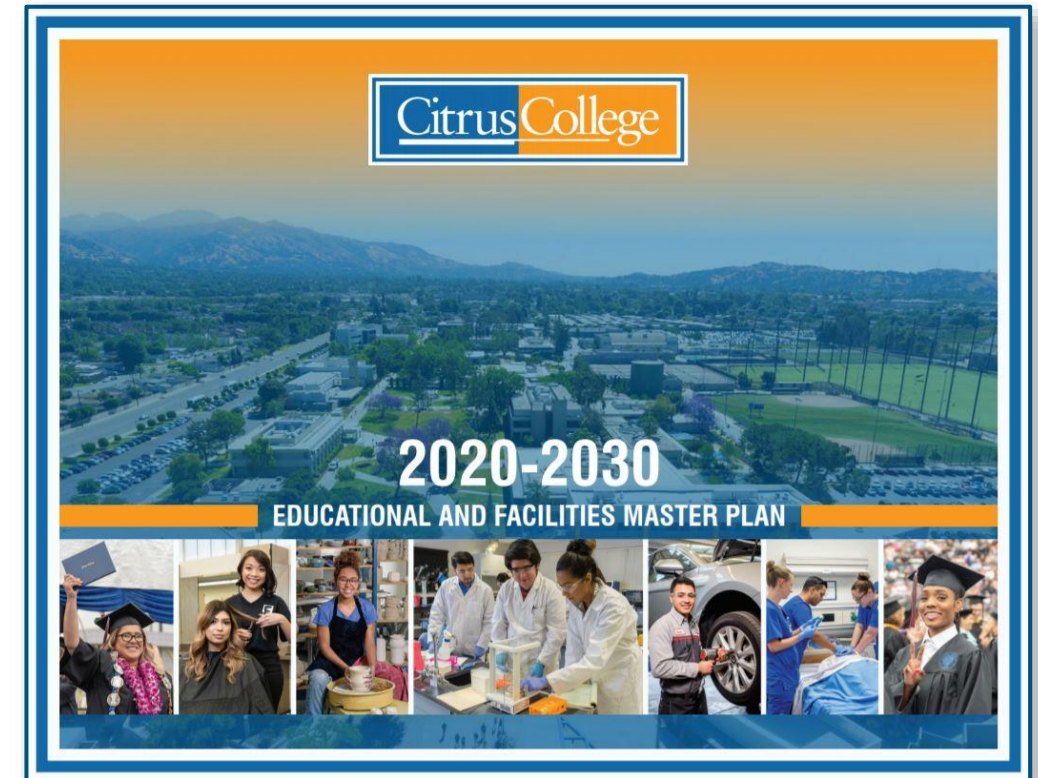
- Favorable outcome from indoor air quality assessment obtained

- New Sustainability Plan developed, following the completion of the 2020-2030 EFMP



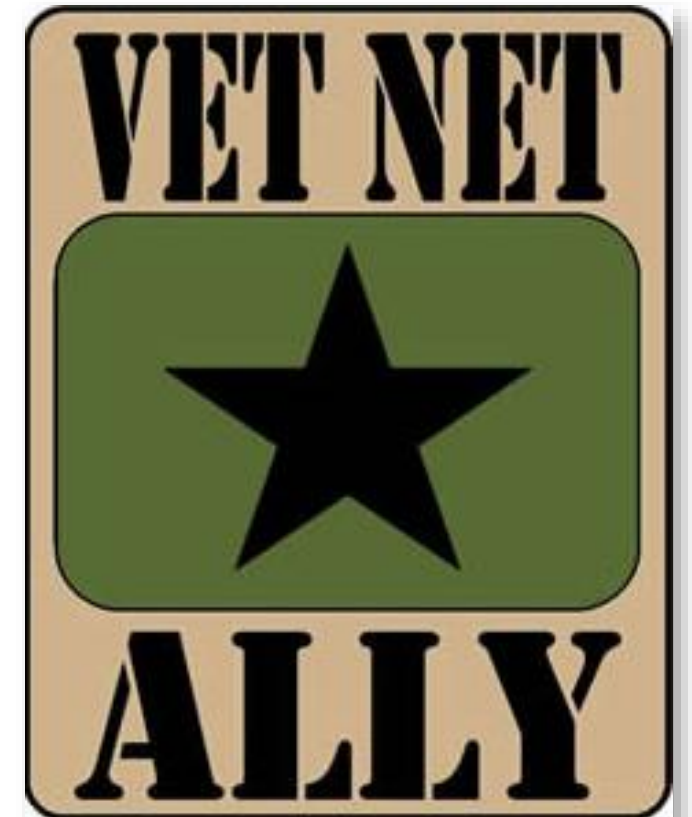
## Focus Area 8: Technological Advancement

- New Sociology course offered, increasing appreciation of cultural diversity and sense of inclusion



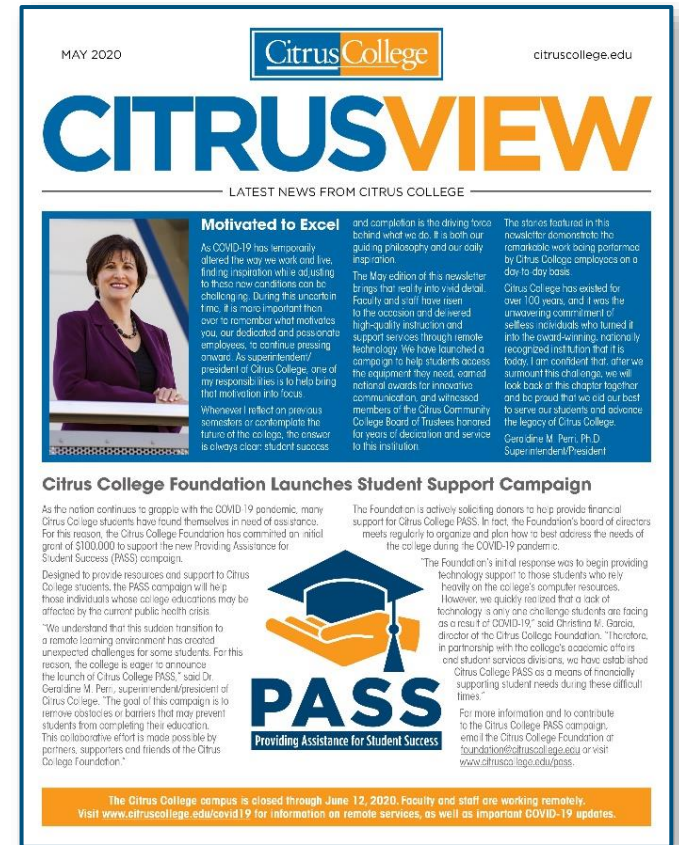
# Focus Area 10: Image
