



## 2008-09 Cohort

  - 2011-2012: additional 7.65%


## 2008-09 Collegewide Student Population







## Remedial Metric by Ethnicity




Percentage of Students Who Started Below Transfer Level in English, Mathematics, and/or ESL and Completed a College-Level Course in the Same Discipline






## Persistence by Gender






## 30 Units by Ethnicity

Percentage of Cohort Who Completed At Least 30 Units in the CCC System








## 30 Units by Gender






## Completion by Ethnicity

Percentage of Cohort Who Completed a Degree, Certificate or Transfer Related Outcome Within Six Years







Percentage of Students Who Completed a Minimum of 8 CTE Units and Ultimately Completed a Degree, Certificate or Transferred


