## Commencement

After much consideration, the decision was made to offer an in-person ceremony to adequately honor our 2020 graduates and give them the recognition they deserve for all their hard work, while ensuring the health and safety of the college community. As such, commencement 2020 will be **postponed until Saturday, December 5, 2020**, with a back-up rain date of December 7, 2020.

## **Summer Session**

As our summer session registration dates are quickly approaching, there remains a great deal of uncertainty regarding COVID-19 and the future of the "stay-at-home" order. Thus, in order to provide students with safe instructional modalities, Citrus College will continue to **offer classes remotely for the summer 2020 session: June 22 - August 14, 2020**.

The physical campus remains closed through June 12, 2020. Plans for a physical return of staff this summer are still being determined, and information will be shared as soon as it becomes available. At this time, employees deemed essential personnel may be required to access the campus for critical operational functions, on a limited basis and with prior approval.

We will continue to base our future decisions on guidance from state and county health officials.
