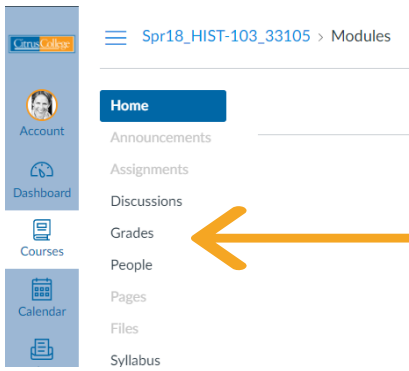


TECH TIP #1: MESSAGE STUDENTS THROUGH THE CANVAS GRADEBOOK

You can send a message from the gradebook to students who haven't turned in an assignment or who didn't reach a certain score, giving them specific tips to help them in the future.

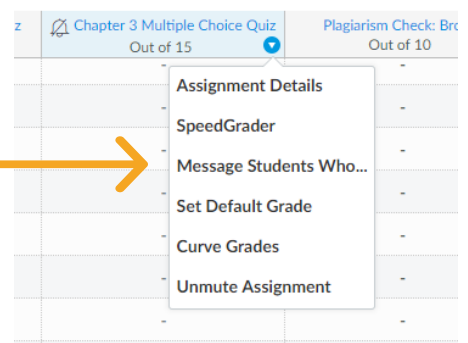

Click on GRADES in the left hand navigation menu.

Hover over the assignment title, click the downward arrow, and select MESSAGE STUDENTS WHO

Choose message criterion and type message.
