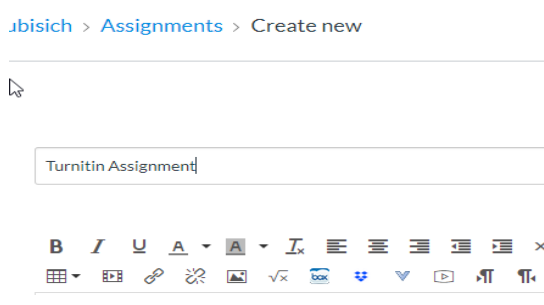


TECH TIP #5: USING TURNITIN IN CANVAS

Turnitin is an integrated tool in Canvas. Learn how to create assignments inside your Canvas Course that use Turnitin to check for originality in your students' work.

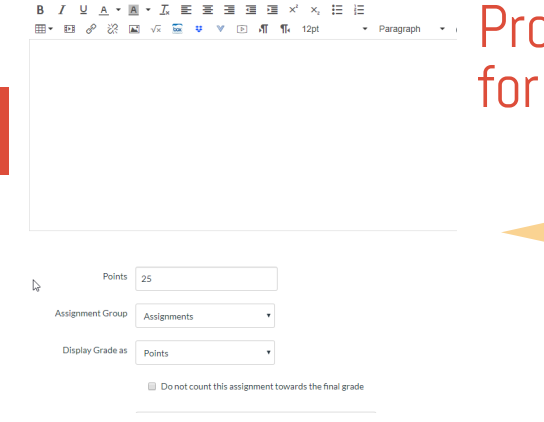
TURNITIN LTI

- 1** Turnitin is an LTI - Learning Tool Integration in Canvas. You can make any assignment a turnitin assignment



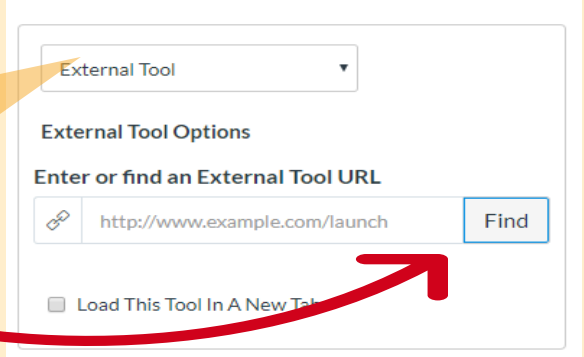
From inside a module or from the course navigation menu, select "+Assignment"

- 2** Provide the instructions and details for your assignment.



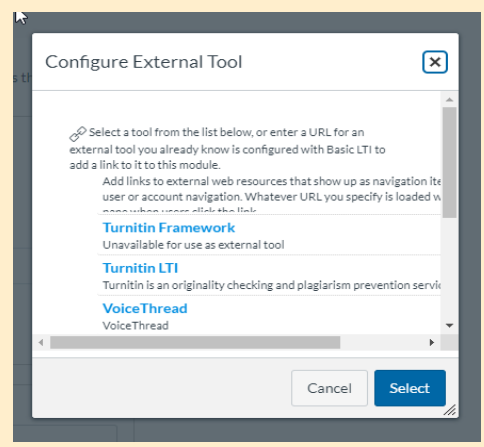
Select External Tool

- 3** Select "External Tool" for the submission type on the assignment.



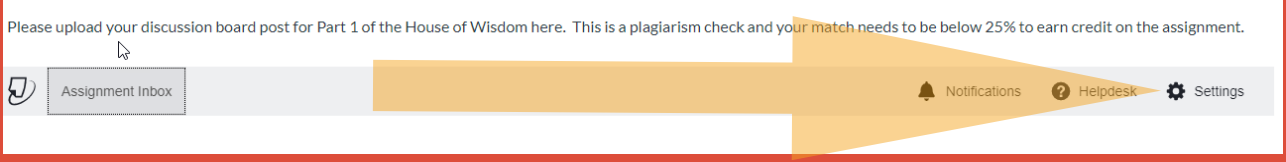
Then click on the FIND button

- 3a** Select "Turnitin LTI" as the tool for the assignment, set your due date on the Canvas "Create Assignment page", and save.

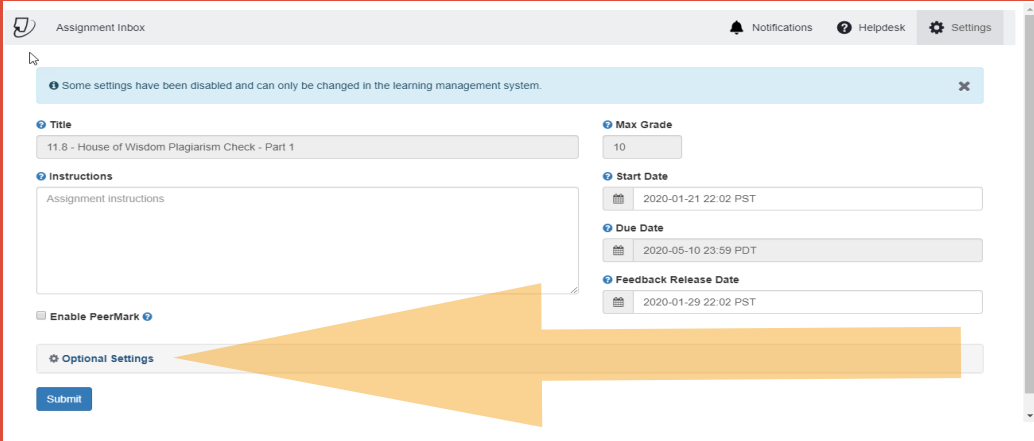


Adjust Turnitin Settings

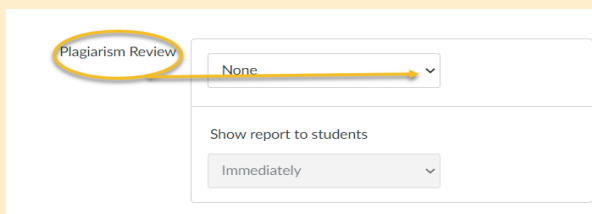
- 4** From the Assignment Inbox, you can personalize your Turnitin settings.



- 4a** "Optional Settings" gives you access to originality report settings and grammar check.

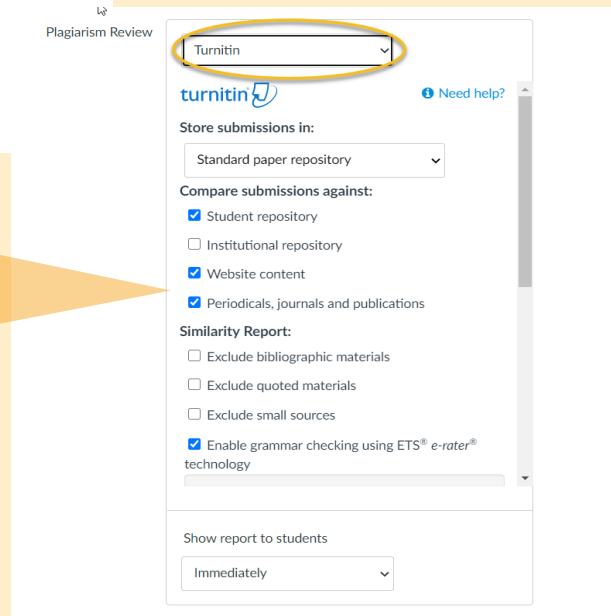


- 5** Another option is to select "Plagiarism Review" when you create an assignment. You can then customize within an assignment.



Choose the repositories you would like to check and what to include or exclude in the similarity report.

This is a good option if you are using a Canvas rubric for grading!



- 6** You will be able to view and check the Turnitin results from the grade book and inside Speedgrader.
